### Warnings

Under certain usage conditions, the inside of the lens may become foggy. In such cases, discontinue use temporarily and ensure that the fogging has been removed before resuming use.

Eyeguards are manufactured to protect the eyes, but eye injuries may occur if the player is subject to a severe impact or depending on the nature of the movement involved. Neither Yamamoto Kogaku Co., Ltd. nor its dealers guarantee that eyeguards will not be destroyed nor that the possibility of eye damage will be eliminated by wearing an eyeguard.

Adjust the eyeguard, dedicated strap, and side pads so that they fit snugly and comfortably.

Incorrect use without observing proper usage instructions may cause permanent damage to your eyes.

## ⚠ Cautions for Usage

- We recommend the use of our petroid lenses with excellent impact resistance for eyeguards. Do not use the eyeguard without the lenses in place.
- Do not use this product for anything other than sports. Be sure to wear this product with our dedicated eyeguard strap when
- Always inspect the eyequard before use. Do not use this product if it is significantly deteriorated; if the product is clearly damaged, such as a crack in the lens or frame or a broken nose pad or strap; or if the lens is detached from the frame for any reason.
- Do not place the eyequard near a heater or in a hot car or other hot location (50°C or higher). If the temperature exceeds 50°C, the lens or frame may deform or degrade.
- Do not use organic solvents (thinners, alcohols, etc.) or adhesives on the eyeguard. Doing so may cause deformation or degradation damage.

# Care and Storage Methods

- If the frame or lens become dirty, gently rinse with tap water by stroking the surface of the lens with your finger, then wipe away moisture with a soft cloth and allow to dry naturally. Then store the eyequard in a low-humidity place out of direct sunlight. Especially with regard to multi (AR) coated lenses, leaving them in a dirty state may result in peeling of the coating.
- When storing the eyeguard, put it in the case that was included with purchase. Do not allow hard objects (such as metal objects, buckles, fasteners, plastic objects with corners, etc.) to come into direct contact with the lens surface during storage or transport. External pressure applied to the eyeguard may cause deformation, so be careful not to apply excessive external pressure.
- If the strap becomes dirty, wash it by hand rubbing with cold or lukewarm water, remove excess moisture with a dry towel, then allow it to dry naturally. The strap has undergone anti-bacterial treatment, but the effect is not permanent. The antibacterial effect may be reduced by use or by washing with water.
